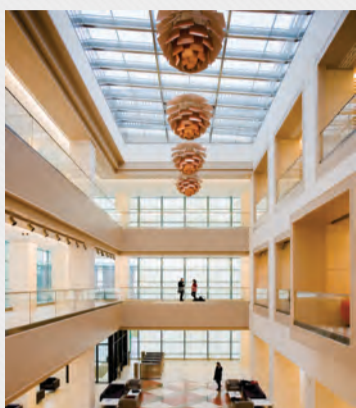


INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP INFORMATION



ADA is a world-class university dedicated to preparing innovative global leaders in a thriving environment. Founded in 2006, ADA is located in Baku, one of the cultural, commercial, and political centers of the Caspian Basin and the ancient Silk Road. ADA is going through exciting and remarkable growth: in September of 2012 it moved to its permanent “green” and “smart” campus, with state-of-the-art facilities including the largest foreign language library in the region. ADA includes four schools: School of Public and International Affairs (SPIA), School of Business (SB), School of Engineering and Information Technology (SEIT) and School of Humanities and Sciences (SHS).

All programs are taught in English. Undergraduate students whose English language skills are not sufficient must complete a one year intensive English Preparatory Program at ADA.

ADA offers full and partial fellowships to outstanding international students enrolled in our programs. A full ADA Fellowship covers tuition, books and accommodation. Fellowship recipients are expected to cover all other expenses, including student fees, utilities, medical checkups and plane tickets. In order to retain this support, undergraduate fellows must meet a minimum annual GPA of 2.5. Graduate fellows must obtain a minimum semester GPA of 3.0 for continuation of fellowship.

ADA currently hosts 45 students from 27 countries in a total student body of 700 (2013), as well as 27 international staff and faculty from 10 countries. Students have a chance to spend one academic semester in one of our partner universities located in Europe, the United States, South America and Asia.
