She took a degree in Architecture at Naples University in March 1991. Qualified as an architect in July 1991, from March 1991 to April 2000 she carried out research work and scientific cooperation at Building Engineering Department of “Federico II” Naples University. In April 1999 she got the title of Doctor in Research at “Federico II” Naples University. On August 1st, 2003 she obtained an University researcher position for disciplinary-scientific sector ICAR/10 - Technical Architecture - at Salerno University Civil Engineering Department. From October 1st, 2007 she is Associate Professor for the disciplinary sector ICAR/10, *Technical Architecture* and *Recovery and Conservation of Buildings*, inside the Building Engineering - Architecture degree. On February 2014 she obtained the National Scientific Qualification to function as a full professor for the sector 08/C1 - Design and Technological Architecture Design.

Her interests are in the history of the buildings, with particular reference to the period of the early 20th century, and the recovery of the traditional buildings.

She is author of numerous publications including: articles in books, papers in professional journals, contributions in either conference proceedings or national and international seminars. She also edited international conference proceedings and published several monographs.
