Graduated in Building Engineering and Architecture at University of Salerno, since November 2016 he is responsible for the research project *The echo of the cloisters, restoration and valorisation of the ancient convents in Salerno*, selected for UID at XXIV “Salone del Restauro\_Musei of Ferrara: Historic centers”. He won several architecture competitions: The International Energy Competition promoted by Delta S.p.a, featuring with University of Pisa and University of Siena, focused on the architectural and energetic upgrading of an ancient barn in Italy, with the project entitled *Zero, Beauty Without Wasting*; Design competition entitled “House for tomorrow”, promoted by Leroy Merlin Italy with the co-housing project named *Roots, there is no alternative to sharing*, about the sustainable reuse of an ancient building.
